When Mayor Vicente Bermejo assumed office, she was designated as the Public Office Service Office (PESO) Manager tasked to manage programs that will generate employment being one of the strategic initiatives of Mayor Vicente B. Bermejo. She is hardworking, creative, committed and passionate in serving the public.



She launched “Halad ni Mayor Vicente B. Bermejo, Trabaho para sa Capiceno” which is a package of opening formal and informal employment opportunities for the people of Roxas City and Capiz. She organized job fairs, recruitment activities and mobile passporting and firmed up partnership with other agencies for livelihood programs. She facilitated the introduction of healthy food products in the market with the Veggie Bread Project made of Kalabasa Flour. She facilitated and organized training for recruits before their formal admission as call center agents. She is consistent with her advocacies against illegal recruitment and ensures that those she process for job placement abroad have corresponding job orders to protect them from human trafficking. Her persistence and commitment have put Roxas City in the map of the labor market.

Madelaine is the Medical Officer IV of the City Health Office. She is the coordinator of the Protection and Promotion of family health. Her dedication to her duties contributed to the successful implementation of the Birthing clinic which has now catered to 904 deliveries and 144 referrals from the time it was established until October of 2009. She also contributed to the increase of beneficiaries of the Expanded Program on Immunization from 87% in 2007 to 94.5% in 2008. She is a lecturer and facilitator of midwives and nurses for early detection and management of common childhood diseases and even acts as the foster parent to 3 teenagers in crisis.

She has extensive training in new-born screening and BEmONC (Basic Emergency Maternal and New Born Care) learnings that she uses in her job. She is soft-spoken and humble which endears her to her patients and co-workers. She generously shares her time, talent and even financial resources to uplift the condition of her indigent patients. She received the Top Performer in Family Planning Award in 2008.
